Position Overview:

We are seeking a Labelling and Packaging Manager to oversee and manage all aspects of the labelling, case packaging, palletization and preparation of goods for inventory. You work in coordination with Batchers and Filling Department Manager, and in conjunction with HACCP, QC and SQF Managers, Maintenance Managers and Plant Manager. General requirements include:

- Supervise, manage and direct Production Line Operators within the Labelling and Packaging Department, including
 participation in the hiring of new employees, and annual performance review/disciplinary action for Production Line Operators
 in your department.
- Production area managers are the primary knowledge holders and the person responsible for the setup, adjustment, and
 ongoing fine-tuning of production equipment including conveyors, check weighers, labellers, case packing equipment,
 palletization equipment, and various other pieces of equipment to ensure optimal output. A high level of mechanical ability is
 required to adequately fulfill the needs of the position.
- During any equipment failures, Production Managers are expected to promptly assess and remedy the failure to mitigate line down-time. In instances where equipment failure requires further assistance, promptly contact the Maintenance department for further assistance.
- Closely monitor equipment and products during production sequence to ensure that all quality and safety parameters are met, and that safe operation of equipment is observed at all times.
- Review and sign-off on operational documentation such as lot code logs, equipment check logs, jar reject logs, and various other records as required by Quality Control department.
- Maintain equipment, tools, and other assets of the company in optimal operating condition with the primary objective of keeping the labelling and packaging line equipment functional and reliable.
- Manage receipt and inventory control of labels and packaging materials in coordination with the Purchasing department
- Follow equipment Standard Operating Procedures and assist with operator training when new equipment or changes to current equipment or processes are implemented. Participation in the development/improvement in SOP's is highly encouraged of all Managers.
- Ensure inventory management of required spare parts and supplies for production equipment.

- Follow all required health and safety protocols and practices.
- Work may involve lifting and handling heavy items (boxes, etc.). using Lifting Devices Equipment &/or manually. Appropriate Lift Truck Operations training and certification will be provided.
- Be familiar with and have regard for HACCP, GMP (Good Manufacturing Practices), Food Safety, Food Security, Organic Certification, Standard Operating Procedures and all other applicable regulatory and company programs and policies. Ensure all workers are aware and comply.
- Adapt to flexible work style and willingly assist with other functions where needed. Hours may be variable, from time to time, according to production requirements, maintenance work, and repairs. Shift work may be required as the Company adapts to change.

Ideal Candidate:

We welcome applications from candidates from all walks of life- our ideal candidate possesses the following skills and qualities:

- **Mechanically Inclined** our state-of-the-art facility is fully automated and is equipped with sophisticated production machinery, so having a knack for mechanics is a huge plus!
